
The Journey from Boyhood to Manhood

Seven Stages of a Man's Life

1. Pre-natal – conception to birth

2. Infancy—birth to one year of age

3. Boyhood -2 years to 10 years

- 4. Young manhood 10 to 16 years
- 5. Manhood 16 to 35 years
- 6. Mentor -35 to 55 years

7. Patriarch – 55 years to death

A Critical Stage for Parents

The most important and critical time for a Dad to capture a young child's heart often is between stage 3-4

Stage# 3 Boyhood - Stage #4 Young Boyhood

This is an important stage need to be handled intentionally and involves both Mom and Dad.

Remember to pray together as parents for wisdom!

Dad's Job

Be the hero in your Son's life! (Enjoy this stage as it is subject to change!)

Lead by Example (more important than words)

- Dad must be honest
- Dad must be real
- Dad must be faithful
- Dad must be a man of the Word.
- Dad must be a man of the Spirit

Mom's Job

Mom's need to encourage their sons to become men

Mom's need to recognize and be willing to let go of their sons as they are becoming men.

Mom's need to quit doting on their sons so they do become men
