Foundations for Life

Identity is our core understanding of how I see myself in how I relate to my world.

We are our memory. It contains all of the data about who we are up to the present. Some of that data is helpful, some of it is flawed, some of it is hurts and wounds. If we continue to get our identity from who we were before Christ, when we learned to live independently of God, we will live out of our unhealed soul where the memories of hurt and pain reside.

It is not what we do that determines who we are; it is who we are that determines what we do.

Sessions

1. Knowing God

It is greatly problematic to be created in the image of God and yet to have distorted unbiblical concepts of God. The Teaching focuses on God's detailed description of Himself from Exodus 34:5-7.

2. Identity - Positional Truth

Does my identity align with what God says? How does our family, life experiences, and community affect our identities? We will learn how our identity defines our purpose and significance.

3. Identity - Design #1 - Self Acceptance

The key to God's principle of design is self-acceptance. God created each of us with at least 10 unique 'unchangeables'. How does accepting our unique designs open us to seeing God's grace?

4. Identity - Design #2 - God's Grace

We all have 3 tanks that need to be filled: Love, Belonging, and Significance. God's gift of grace through Jesus was designed to meet those needs and to give us value, power and hope. And yet we must each be vigilant for Satan's counterfeits.

5. Identity - Created to Bear God's Image

Gen 1:26 Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, in our likeness... So, God created man in His own image. Our designed purpose is to: mirror His nature, be His representative, and to do the work we were designed for

6. Forgiveness

Few deny the importance of forgiveness yet few understand what forgiveness is or even how to forgive. Our goal in this teaching will be to look at how the scripture defines forgiveness, particularly as Jesus defines forgiveness as 'cancelling debt' in Matthew 18

7. Understanding Love

While "love" has a number of meanings in our current culture, the Hebrew Language from the Old Testament complicated things more. The Old Testament has 11 Hebrew words for "love". Come and gain a deeper understanding of God's love.

8. Mastering Desire

Typically, we define sin from the perspective of behavior. But the root of sin is always relational.

"To him who overcomes, I will give the right to sit with me on my throne." Rev 3:21

9. The Power of Choice

There are 5 characteristics of maturity: Accepting and taking control of our life, Taking responsibility, Containing your emotions, Having perspective, and Achieving a deep understanding.

10. Pursuing Purity of Heart

Part of God's image that He placed into mankind was creative power. Why did God create us as sexual beings. What is His plan and purpose?
